Temporary Business means any one or any combination of the following:

- i) the sale of goods, merchandise, or services sold by a business being operated or carried on in the Municipality in or out of a permanent building for a period of less than six weeks;
- ii) the sale of goods, merchandise, or services by a business operating or being carried on out of a vehicle, truck or trailer; and
- iii) the carrying from dwelling to dwelling or from place to place, and the offer for sale, of goods, merchandise or services, including any marketing activity conducted in respect thereof

Temporary Business operator means a person who operates or carries on a temporary business
