

By-law No. PD-002: RESPECTING CIVIC NUMBERING

The Council of the Municipality of Grand Bay-Westfield under authority vested in it by Section 10 of the *Local Governance Act*, SNB 2017, c.18 and amendments thereto enacts as follows:

RECITALS

- 1. Whereas:
 - (a) the Town of Grand Bay-Westfield provides police protection and fire protection and other services to its residents; and
 - (b) it is important that buildings and properties be properly identified by civic numbers in order to provide such services; and
- 2. Whereas the *Emergency 911 Act*, RSNB 2011, c.146 (together with the regulations made thereunder, the "**Emergency 911 Act**") provides for the assignment of civic addresses to residences and business located with the Province of New Brunswick and requires the owner or occupier of a residence or business in the Province of New Brunswick to display the civic address so that the number is clearly visible from the principle roadway leading to the residence or business;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Grand Bay-Westfield enacts the following By-law.

SHORT TITLE

3. This By-law may be cited as the Civic Numbering By-law.

ASSIGNING CIVIC NUMBERS

- 4. The Development Officer is responsible for assigning civic numbers to residences and businesses fronting upon or abutting a street for the purposes of the Emergency 911 Act. The Town of Grand Bay-Westfield shall keep a record of the civic numbers which have been assigned.
- 6. A civic number previously assigned by the former Town of Grand Bay, the former Town of Grand Bay-Westfield or the Province of New Brunswick in the former Local Service District of Westfield West, and the residence or business in respect of

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which has not subsequently been assigned a different civic number, is valid for the purpose of this By-law unless directed otherwise by the Development Officer.

REPEAL

7. By-law No. 7, a By-law of the Town of Grand Bay-Westfield Respecting the Civic Numbering of Buildings and Property, enacted 23 February 1998, and all amendments thereto, are hereby repealed.
