By-law No. PR-001: RESPECTING ROADS ACCESSIBLE TO OFF-ROAD VEHICLES

Pursuant to the powers conferred by the *Off-Road Vehicle Act*, R.S.N.B 1985, c. O-1.5 and its amendments, the Council of the Town of Grand Bay -Westfield duly assembled enacts as follows:

Definitions:

Off-road vehicle as defined in the Off-Road Vehicle Act but restricted to members of the New Brunswick All-Terrain Vehicle Federation (N.B.A.T.V.F.) or in another province member of a reciprocal agreement with New Brunswick.

General provisions:

- a) Off-road vehicles shall display a valid trail permit as required under the Off-Road Vehicle Act or a valid trail permit from another Province having a reciprocal agreement with New Brunswick, this license being in the form of a sticker which must be clearly and permanently displayed on the ATV or Side-by-Side. The driver must be immediately able to provide a registration document and an insurance document for the vehicle. A license plate with a valid sticker must be visible.
- b) No person shall drive an Off-Road vehicle on any roadway within Town limits other than at locations designated for this purpose and as further set out below on a map attached to this By-law as Schedule "A".
- c) Off-road vehicles must travel in the same direction as traffic and shall move in single file on the far right of the street.
- d) Any other vehicle utilizing the street shall have the right of way.
- e) No person shall operate an off-road vehicle in such a way as to disrupt or destroy the natural environment, create a nuisance by method or frequency of operation on any municipal property or upon any highway within the municipality.

f) Off-Road vehicles may be driven along Highland Road as set out in Schedule "A" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h. I certify that this instrument J'atteste que cet instrument est is registered or filed in the

- g) Off-Road vehicles may be driven along Colonel Nase Boulevard as set out in Schedule "A" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h.
- h) Off-Road vehicles may be driven along Route 177 as set out in Schedule "A" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h.
- i) The driver or any occupant of the off-road vehicle must be properly wearing a helmet that complies with the standards prescribed by Regulations established under the Motor Vehicle Act.
- j) The Off-Road Vehicle must be outfitted with the necessary equipment as described in accordance with the Off-Road Vehicle Act.
- k) Off-road vehicles shall give the appropriate signals as required under the Motor Vehicle Act and must obey all traffic control devices.
- I) No person shall operate an Off-Road Vehicle on the travelled portion of Highland Road, Colonel Nase Boulevard or Route 177 unless they are in possession of a valid driver's license.
- m) Schedule "A" forms an integral part of this By-law.

3. Offences:

a) Anyone who violates this By-Law commits a punishable offence and is liable to a fine of \$100.00, in addition to any fine under the Off-Road Vehicle Act, SNB 1985, c O-1.5 and its amendments.

4. Coming into force:

This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date it is passed, signed, and sealed.

READ A FIRST TIME by title this <u>23rd</u> day of <u>January</u>, 2023.

READ A SECOND TIME by title this <u>23rd</u> day of <u>January</u>, 2023.

READ A THIRD TIME by title and ENACTED on this <u>11th</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2023.

This By-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.
